



Individualized Homoeopathic Approach of Plaque Psoriasis- A CASE REPORT

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ABSTRACT-

Psoriasis is a genetically determined inflammatory and proliferative disease of skin, the most characteristic lesions consisting of chronic, sharply demarcated, dull red scaly plaques, particularly on the extensor prominences and in the scalp. It's course is punctuated by intermissions and remissions. According to recent studies, the psoriasis prevalence in India is approximately ranging from 0.42 to 2.28%. Besides conventional dermatologic treatment many patient choose Homoeopathic treatment for this condition due to their efficacy & lack of side effects. In this article we report a case of plaque psoriasis treated till recovery with Pulsatilla Nigricans which was prescribed according to individualization of patient.

INTRODUCTION- Psoriasis is a common non- infectious disease considered to be a chronic autoimmune condition, T- cell mediated, characterized by faster replacement of epidermis cells on the basal membrane level consequently causing inflammation and scaling, affecting 2-3% of population.

Plaque psoriasis typically presents with large oval circular plaques over the scalp, trunk and extensor body surfaces. The plaques have an extensive amount of scaling due to hyperproliferation of epidermal cells. Most patients have acute flares and relapses of plaque psoriasis which may sometime become severe. Plaque psoriasis occurs in approximately 90% of psoriasis.

Females tend to develop psoriasis earlier than males. Patient with a family history of psoriasis tend to have an early age of onset. The attacks are more common in winter than summer, the eruption has a natural tendency to clear up with warm weather.

AETIOLOGY-

- Genetic predisposition
- Immunological factors
- Environmental factors i.e. sunlight, metabolic factor, drugs, psychogenic factor, alcohol and smoking.

CLINICAL VARIANTS-

- Psoriasis vulgaris / Plaque psoriasis- Characterized by dry scaly patches.
- Pustular Psoriasis- Contain pus like fluid mainly infiltrated with white blood cells.
- Erythrodermic Psoriasis- Characterized by exfoliation of fine scaly skin with pain & itching.
- Guttate Psoriasis- Characterized by drop like dots.
- Flexural Psoriasis / Inverse psoriasis- Affects the flexure surfaces and characterized by smooth inflamed lesion.
- Other including scalp psoriasis and nail psoriasis.

A CASE REPORT

A 30 year old female came with the complaint of psoriasis on 30/12/20. Patient suffering from this condition since last 2 years and at initial stage patches appeared on the legs. The lesions consisting of sharply demarcated, dull red, dry and scaly patches with itching.

HISTORY OF PRESENT COMPLAINTS & TREATMENT TAKEN

The patient was apparently well 2 years back then she gradually developed a fine flaky scale on extensor surfaces of lower extremities. Initially it was a small red patch which later spreading all over the legs. She used some topical medicine & also took ayurvedic treatment, which palliate her symptoms for some time but after their effect reduces, itching started again.

PHYSICAL GENERALS

- Thirst- Decreased , 2-3 glass per day (Only while eating)
- Desire- Dairy products (Curd, buttermilk, yogurt)
- Urine- Burning sensation in urethra before urination

CLINICAL OBSERVATION-

- Appearance- Wheatish, pale complexion.
- Height- 5'0
- Weight- 69 kgs.
- Pulse- 74 beats /min
- Pallor- Present
- Other general and systemic examination findings suggest no abnormal sign.

TREATMENT PLANNED /MEDICATION-

Pulsatilla Nigricans 200 one dose was prescribed after taking the case and 200 potency prescribed according to susceptibility of the patient & nature of medicine & disease. After that patient was given Rubrum 200 for 30 days.

Rx

Pulsatilla Nigricans 200 /1 dose /H.S.

Rubrum 30 /TDS/ for 30 Days

Patient was also advised for local application of plain coconut oil and intake of water frequently. Avoidance of oily & spicy food.

FOLLOW UP WITH PRESCRIPTION
