III. YOUNGSTERS AND CLOUD COMPUTING

Nowadays youngsters are continuously experiencing the benefits of cloud computing strategy. A best example of this is the usage of web-based e-mail services. If you have an account with web based e-mail services like Gmail, Yahoo, Hotmail, etc, then you are actually logging in to a Web e-mail account remotely instead of running an e-mail program from your local computer. The cloud computing services are categorized into various types based on their mode of service. The various cloud computing types include;

1. IaaS – Infrastructure as a Service
The service provider uses a piece of software, hardware or firmware which creates and runs virtual machines.
2. PaaS – Platform as a Service
The service provider offers a computing platform that consists of Web server, Mail server, Operating system, etc. It refers to the environment in which the application run or operate like Operating System (OS) may be rented from the vendor eg. Databases.
3. SaaS – Software as a Service

SaaS is referred to on-demand software. It is priced as a pay-per-user basis. It refers to any type of software program that is managed remotely and delivered via the web. The example of SaaS are Google Apps for Education and Microsoft Office 365(O365) which provide communication and office applications such as email and spreadsheets

IV. CLOUD SERVICES AND ITS USE BY YOUNGSTERS

The cloud computing technology is popular in youth by making drastic revolutions in the Internet world by means of social networking. The cloud computing could exactly analyze and fulfil the interests and demands of youth.

To know the awareness of cloud computing technology 200 youngsters were selected from Aurangabad city. The gender wise response were received as per Chart 1.

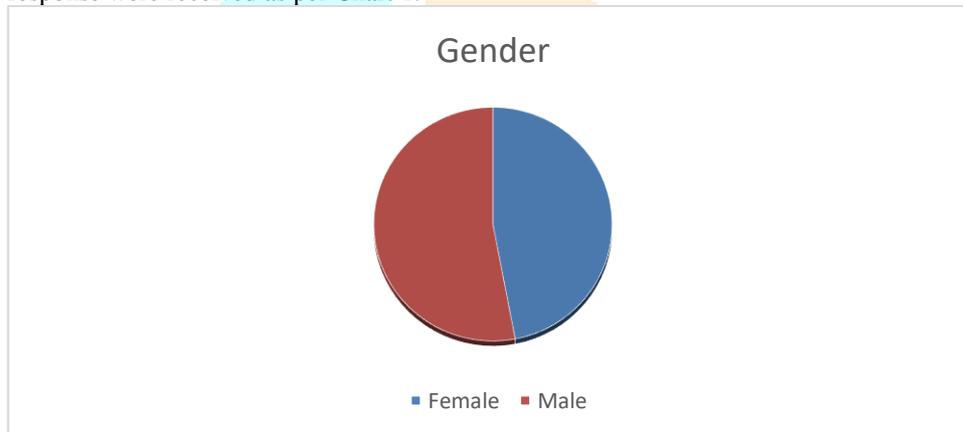


Chart 1: Gender Ratio in percentage

As per Chart 1 it is observed 47% of female candidates and 53% male candidates were participated in the study having basic knowledge of smart phones. There is marginal difference between the gender ration for basic knowledge of smart phones. In general it is also observed that youngsters using cloud services but don't know that they are using cloud computing technology.

The youngsters were divided into 5 age groups as per char 2 from age 18 to 28.

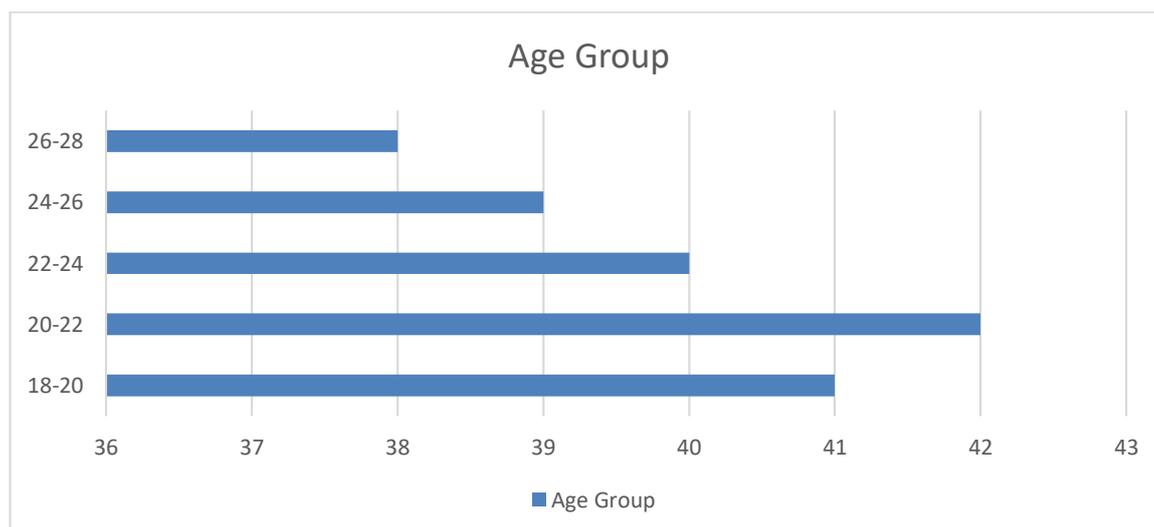


Chart 2: Age groups

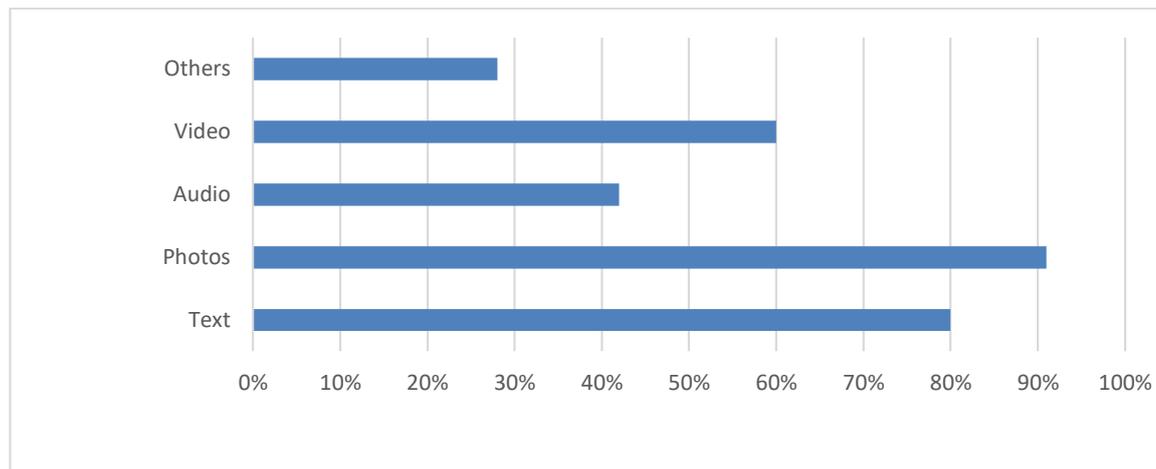


Chart 3. Contents used by youngsters in cloud

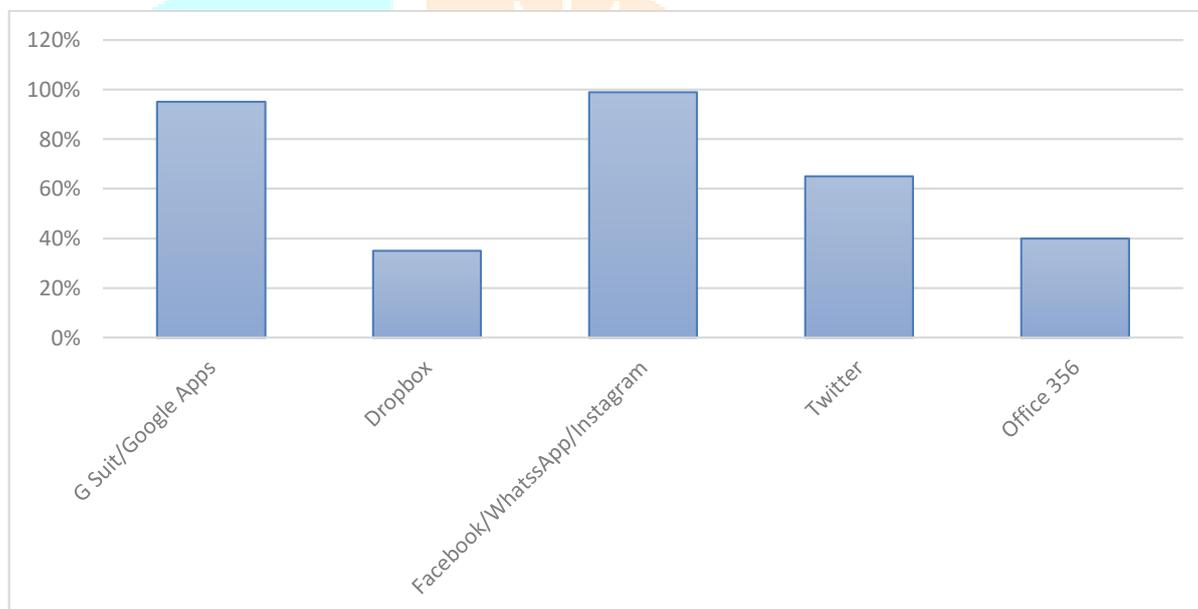


Chart 4. The commonly used cloud applications

The most commonly used cloud application by youngsters is Facebook, its messenger WhatsApp and Instagram. Instagram and WhatsApp Inc. was acquired by Facebook in 2012 and 2014 respectively. Second commonly used cloud application is G Suite/Google Apps offered by Google. G Suite is a set of cloud computing, productivity and collaboration tools, software and products having word processing spreadsheets, presentation software, e-mail programs, storage, calendar, etc. developed by Google Cloud, first launched on August 28, 2006 as Google Apps.. Third most commonly used cloud application is Dropbox, a file hosting service operated by the American company Dropbox, Inc. which is offering cloud storage, file synchronization, personal cloud, and client software. Twitter and Instagram are quite popular due to its role in social networking. Office 360/O365 by Microsoft is also a popular cloud application used to collaborate for free with online versions of Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, and OneNote, Save documents, spreadsheets, and presentations online, etc.

1. Only students from age 18-28 were selected for the study.
2. Geographic data from Aurangabad city were selected for the study.

VI. FINDINGS OF THE STUDY

1. The researcher found that there is marginal difference between the gender ration for basic knowledge of smart phones.(Chart 1)
2. It is also observed that youngsters using cloud services but don't know that they are using cloud computing technology.
3. It is found that youngsters are passionate about photos for sharing and uploading on cloud and texting comes after that.(Chart 3)
4. The researcher reveals that the most commonly used cloud application by youngsters is G Suit/Google Apps offered by Google, due to the affordable Android Smart Phones by Google.
